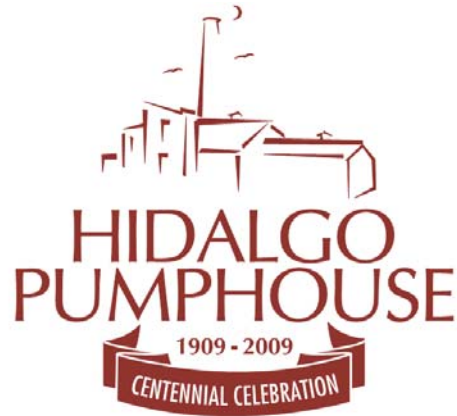

Rules and Regulations:

- Check in time is 8:00 am with mandatory cooks meeting at 8:30 am
- All teams will receive a 30x30 space
- All meat will be marinated, prepared and cooked on site
- Participants will furnish their own cooking utensils and barbeque pit. No gas or butane grills allowed. Fire can only be inside of pit, not on or directly in ground.
- Each cooking team will submit approximately 1 lb of fajita beef skirt steak for competition. Fajita should be cut into 10 strips, 1 inch wide (thickness and length do not matter as long as all of the 10 strips fit into the Styrofoam box given at cooks meeting)
- Each team will also submit 2, 16oz cups of charro beans for competition. Cups will be given to each team during cooks meeting.
- Each team will submit 7 individual pork spare ribs, bone in
- Each team will submit ½ chicken fully jointed with breast, wing, thigh and drumstick
- Entries will be judged on flavor, texture, aroma and appearance
- No late entries will be accepted.
- Event is blind judging. If markings are found on entry container, it will be automatically disqualified.
